Chiseled returns to the ICE District Plaza January 18

Activate Arts Alberta (formally Ice on Whyte) is pleased to announce the return of *Chiseled* - Edmonton's International Ice Carving Competition to the ICE District Plaza January 18 – 20, 2024. Seven two-person teams have 34 hours to create beautiful 15-block ice sculptures. The scale, talent, and precision are something to behold. Each block is 1 m X 50 cm X 25 cm (40" X 20" X 10") and weighs 135 kg (297 lbs). The pieces are judged on artist merits and technical expertise with the winner announced on Jan. 20th. This year's winner will receive an invitation from the World Ice Carving Association to be a part of the International Ice Festival Madrid-Torrejon for the 2026 Winter Olympics.

You can watch these winter masterpieces come to life by visiting the ICE District Plaza on the competition days according to the following schedule:

Thursday January 18 - 8am - 10pm - stacking blocks and begin carving

Friday January 19 - 8am - 10pm - carving day

Saturday January 20 - 8am - 2pm - finishing touches and details.

Any weather above zero temperatures may alter this schedule.

The carvers will be using a variety of tools and techniques including chainsaws, chisels, and their own unique tools to get the exact creation they are looking. Viewing is free and open to the public.

These breath-taking sculptures will remain as the perfect winter backdrop for all the exciting events happening in the ICE District until the end of February or until the weather takes. Voting for the People's Choice Award remains until February 28th and can be found at: <u>iceonwhyte.ca.</u>
